

Reading

Reading will continue to take place daily. Four sessions a week will be dedicated to fluency and comprehension and one session a week will aim to develop a real love of reading through a variety of activities. We will look at developing our retrieval and inference skills and build up our understanding of new vocabulary. Please continue to read at home daily and add this to Boom Reader.

Writing

Using our key quality texts, we will take the children on a writing journey that allows them to express their ideas creatively. We will be using a range of different text features in our writing, then after editing and improving, we will publish our writing. Please utilise the Emile App at home to consolidate spelling knowledge.

Mathematics

In maths, we will be continuing to develop our knowledge of mass and capacity, shape, space and measure, time and money.

We will continue to practise our fluency skills and will spend time reviewing addition and subtraction. Times tables practise will be a focus. Please continue to use TTRockstars for daily practise.

Science

In science this term, we will be looking at the topic of growing plants building on from previous knowledge of plant life cycles. In addition, we will learn about light and dark. As in all science work, we aim to encourage the children to question, formulate ideas and test them in practical work throughout the topic.



History

In Term 5 we will be continuing with the Romans. We will learn about how the Romans had a powerful, organised army and that they invaded Britain. We will also learn that there was a rebellion, led by Boudicca. We will learn how roads and towns were built and now have an impact on our modern way of life.

Geography

In Term 6, we will be studying London and the South East. Children will use maps to study the South East, identifying the shape of the coastline and the location of cities and towns. We will learn that the River Thames has played an important role in London's development. We will look at the physical and human features that make up the South East.


Art & DT

We will be using a range of skills this term to create art work linked to monuments of Ancient Rome. We will look at model making skills including papier mache.. In DT, we will be learning about British cooking and using local produce.. We will develop our cooking skills and follow a recipe to make apple crumble..

PE

We will be learning about ball skills, including sending and receiving passes. We will also look at team games such as rounders and netball.

The Brighton and Hove Coaches will be teaching us precision ball skills and other skills related to a variety of sports.



MFL

We will be revising KS1 French vocabulary, including using it to develop French conversation. We will continue to study the history and architecture of the Eiffel Tower whilst reading 'A Walk in Paris' by Salvatore Rubbino.

PSHE & COMPUTING

PHSE will focus on building positive relationships and Changes. In Computing, children will be programming with the Micro:bit, learning concepts like selection, string input, variables and combining loops with variables.

RE

We will be learning about other religions such as Islam and Sikhism. In both our units we will learn what is the best way for a Muslim or a Sikh to lead a good life..

Music

We will continue learning how to play the recorder with a specialist teacher. There will be a performance at the end of the year to demonstrate all that we have learnt about pace, rhythm, high notes and low notes
