YEAR 5 TOPIC WEB TERMS 3 & 4: Traders and Raiders

Reading

History

Reading will continue to take place daily in Terms 3 and 4. Five sessions a week will be dedicated to fluency and comprehension as well as developing a real love of reading through a variety of activities.

Writing

Using our key quality texts, children will continue to develop their writing skills by writing a set of instructions, a poem, a recount and a persuasive letter. The children will be developing independence in ensuring their writing consists of the appropriate features for their genre of writing and also using a range of ways to present their work.


Mathematics

In Maths, we will be continuing to develop our multiplication and division skills before moving on to fractions and decimals. We will continue to practice our fluency skills and will also spend time reinforcing times table knowledge.

Science

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In Science, we will be further developing our scientific skills through investigations in materials and their properties. We will create fair tests, use research and solve problems around Science.



Geography

We will learn about Britain's settlement by the Anglo Saxons and the Vikings. We will find out about the Anglo and the Vikings Saxon struggle for the kingdom and how they changed the lives of those native to the area.

We will be studying the regions of Europe, linked to our historical studies. We will name and locate counties, cities, regions and features of different European countries and also work on our map skills and understanding.

Art & DT

In art, will be using a range of skills to create art work linked to our topic. We will explore skills in printing and sculpture, including creating dragons' eyes using the medium of clay. Our DT project will involve sewing skills.

The Albion Coaches will be teaching the children ball skills and other skills related to basketball. We will also be exploring and refining gymnastic skills throughout the spring terms.
