Writing


Using our quality key texts, the children will continue to develop important key writing skills by retelling and sequencing narratives, constructing letters and diarv entries and creating information pages based on non-fiction texts.

Mathematics

During Term 1 and 2, the children will continue to develop their understanding of place value, addition and subtraction. We will be learning to identify the tens and ones in two-digit numbers and will be learning to count in 1s, 2s, 3s, 5s and 10s. We will also deepen our knowledge on shape in Term 2.

Science

In Science, we will be learning about Electricity, exploring circuits, Investigating conductivity and learning all about electricity safety. In Term 2 we will begin to investigate materials and matter, discovering the properties of materials and performing fun experiments surrounding solids and liquids.

In History, we are learning all about the Great Fire of London. We will be exploring the timeline of the Great Fire of London and how it impacted the our Capital City. We will be researching Samuel Pepys and reading his diary to help us understand this historical event.

Geography

MFL

PSHE and computing
