INTENT

The Parkland Federation fosters an inclusive learning environment which enables children to develop skills and attitudes that will allow them to understand and positively contribute to modern day society. The teaching of Religious Education encourages children to develop morally, socially, spiritually and culturally. The aim of this learning experience is to support strong mutual respect and to prepare them to be part of an increasingly diverse society.





IMPLEMENTATION

At our school, we explore some of the religions represented in Britain. These are Christianity, Buddhism, Hinduism, Islam, Judaism and Sikhism. Through an enquiry-based approach, we encourage children to develop an understanding of each religion and an ability to explore their own beliefs, those of others and to develop ethical thinking.

The Parkland Federation uses the Discovery RE Scheme of Work to support the teaching of religious studies in a structured way. Each module of study raises key questions which will encourage an investigation into the key concepts of belonging, culture, purpose and values.



Our curriculum encourages personal reflection and mindfulness. This encourages the children to develop resilience as well as emotional intelligence. These moments of reflection encourage the children to explore their own responses to their learning and to develop vital skills in self-awareness.

Our school values of Honesty, Aspiration, Resilience, Positivity and Cooperation are reflected in our respectful learning of world religions and human experience. The teaching of Religious Education, along with all other aspects of the school curriculum, help our pupils to understand the world around them and radiate empathy, generosity, inclusivity and compassion. This is strengthened further by links forged in the local community and through working in partnership with The Spinnaker Foundation.
